

**CITY OF HEIDELBERG
RESOLUTION NO. 2021-04**

**A RESOLUTION TO MAKE A TEMPORARY EXCEPTION TO CHAPTER 5,
SECTION 510.01- SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR.**

WHEREAS, since the City of Heidelberg City Code currently authorizes the issuance of a temporary on-sale license to sell 3.2 malt liquor by a club or charitable, religious, or nonprofit organization;

WHEREAS, when there is a reasonable unavailability of 3.2 malt liquor;

WHEREAS the City of Heidelberg will adopt a temporary exception to Chapter 5, section 510.01 by adding a subsection (1) to subsection (H);


WHEREAS, Chapter 5, Section 510.01, subsection (H) will include a subsection 1 to read as follows:

1. An exception of a temporary on-sale liquor license may be issued when there is a reasonable unavailability of 3.2 malt liquor;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HEIDELBERG, MINNESOTA AS FOLLOWS:**

The City may authorize a temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license when 3.2 malt liquor is reasonably unavailable.
